


Registration Overview

Candidate Guide for the Early Childhood Education CalFTPA Pilot/Field Test

1. Getting Started

Register for the CalFTPA pilot/field test at the <u>Pearson ePortfolio Pilot- and Field-Testing website</u>. Select the link in the website announcement that indicates registration is now open, or select "Candidates" from the top navigation.




Then, on the assessment-specific page, review the important information provided and familiarize yourself with the resources provided here.

Home / Candidates / Early Childhood Education CalFTPA Early Childhood Education CalFTPA Overview The purpose of the Early Childhood Education California Formative Teaching Performance Assessment (ECE CalFTPA) pilot/field test is to collect validity evidence and feedback on the design of the draft assessment. Specifically, Commission-approved educator preparation programs are invited to try out the instructional cycles and related scoring rubrics with their candidates by embedding the cycles and rubrics within existing program requirements. Pilot/field test data—including feedback from surveys of participating teacher candidates, preparation program faculty, and assessors—will inform further revisions to the ECE CalTPA. All candidate submission materials related to the pilot/field test will be kept confidential and secure. On the sign-in screen, click the link to "Create an account now."




The system will take you through the account-creation process, where you will select a password and provide information about yourself, including your full name and address.

If you have previously created an account, you may sign in using your email address and the password you established when you created the account.


3. Register

To continue, you are required to confirm your identity.




A. Choose Your Program

On the Program Selection screen, the system will ask you to select your program from among the assessments that are currently offering pilot or field tests.



B. Select Your Cycle

On the Assessment Selection screen, select the CalFTPA instructional cycle that you wish to register for. You may select one cycle per registration.



C. Answer the Background Questions


You will be asked to answer the following series of questions. When you are registering, answer these questions as best you can. You will be able to update your answers after you register, at any time up until you submit your cycle for scoring.

Question	Instruction
Ethnicity	Select the option that best describes yourself. You may answer this question "Choose not to respond."
Sexual Orientation	Select the option that best describes yourself. You may answer this question "Decline to state."
Language	 Indicate the language(s) you were fluent in as a child. Options are: English only English and one or more other languages American Sign Language only American Sign Language and one or more other languages
Units Completed	Select the option that best indicates at the end of this semester or quarter in which you are submitting this CalTPA cycle, how many units you will have completed in your teacher preparation program. Options are: • 1–11 semester units/1–17 quarter units • 12–23 semester units/18–35 quarter units • 24–40 semester units/36–60 quarter units • 41–60 semester units/61–90 quarter units • More than 60 semester units/More than 90 quarter units

Placement School	 Select the option that best describes the type of school for your teaching placement. Options are: Family Child Care Home Public Elementary School Public/Non-Profit Preschool such as State Preschool or Head Start, not on an Elementary School Campus Private Elementary School Private/For-Profit Preschool, not on an Elementary School Campus College Campus Lab School
Placement Grade Level	Select the educational setting/grade level that best describes the placement in which you are completing the Education Specialist CalTPA. If your classroom contains multiple grades, select the grade level that most closely corresponds to the majority of students with whom you are working. Options are: • Pre-school/Pre-K • TK • K
Program Type	Select the option that best describes the type of educator preparation program in which you are enrolled. Options are: • Certificate • Associates Degree • Baccalaureate Degree

D. Review Your Registration

4. Check Out and Provide Payment




